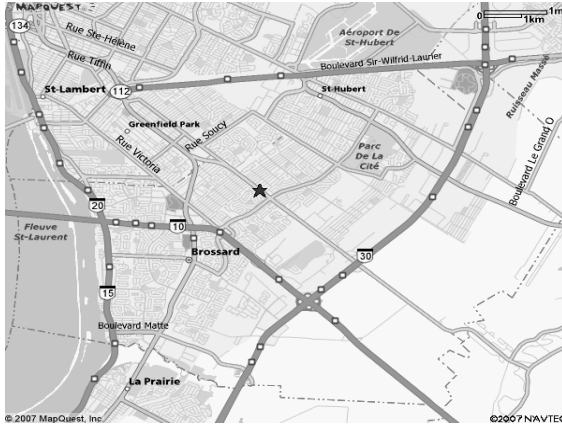

### From Montreal

Take Autoroute # 10 south over the Pont Champlain (Bridge). At the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit, take Taschereau Est (Autoroute # 134) toward Longueuil by turning left at the lights. At the 3<sup>rd</sup> set of lights, turn right onto Auteuil. Go to the 3<sup>rd</sup> set of lights, and turn right at the T-intersection onto Grande Allée. At the 3<sup>rd</sup> set of lights, turn right into Plaza Grande Allée, and we are at the right hand end of the plaza.

### From the West

Take Autoroute # 30 Est to Grande Allée. Exit at Grande Allée and turn left (North), and continue along Grande Allée, through Milan / Gaetan Boucher. At the next set of lights, turn left into Plaza Grande Allée, and we are at the right hand end of the plaza.

### From the South East

Take Autoroute # 116 or Autoroute # 112, and exit at Autoroute # 30. Take Autoroute # 30 West to Grande Allée, and turn right (north). Continue along Grande Allée, through Milan / Gaetan Boucher. At the next set of lights, turn left into Plaza Grande Allée, and we are at the right hand end.

### By Metro / Bus

Take the Metro to Longueuil, and then take Bus # 21 to 5615 Grande Allée.
