- God’s Spirit is NOT is competition with God’s Word.
- Hebrews 8:8-9, NIV – *“But God found fault with the people and said: ‘The time is coming, declares the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah. It will not be like the covenant I made with their forefathers when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt, because they did not remain faithful to my covenant, and I turned away from them, declares the Lord.’”*
- “New”
 - NOT “Neos” = new (time wise)
 - IS “Kainos” = Qualitatively different, nothing in common with, set against, opposed to
- Testament – a testimony how I want my affairs managed (in a qualitative different way).
- Gospel = birth, life, death, burial, resurrection, ascension, outpouring, infilling (not just salvation)
- If you try to run a new program on an old system, your program is going to crash.
- We don’t repent to GET forgiveness, we repent because we HAVE forgiveness.

- Titus 2:11-12, NIV – *“For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men. It teaches us to say “No” to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age ...”*
- Grace plus something isn’t grace!
- New Covenant = new centre of consciousness ... no longer sin consciousness, but righteousness consciousness.
- Repentance is God’s gift to you, not your gift to God.
- The eagle knows how to live consistently with his identity, and within his context, so he is beautiful. He functions according to his divine function and context.
- God’s anointing in you IS His will.
- God doesn’t give us a road map, He gives us a compass (the Holy Spirit).
- Jesus has already given us His glory.
