<p>Satan's Lie: Rejection</p> <p>I must have the approval (acceptance) of certain other people before I can feel good about myself.</p>	<p>Satan's Lie: Failure</p> <p>I must meet certain standards in order to feel good about myself.</p>	<p>God's Truth: Justification</p> <p>I am completely forgiven and fully pleasing to God.</p> <p>Romans 5:1-2, NIV – <i>“Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we rejoice in the hope of the glory of God.”</i></p>	<p>God's Truth: Reconciliation</p> <p>I am totally accepted by God.</p> <p>Colossians 1:21-22, NIV – <i>“Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behavior. But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation.”</i></p>
<p>Satan's Lie: Punishment</p> <p>Those who fail are unworthy of love and deserve to be punished.</p>	<p>Satan's Lie: Shame</p> <p>I am what I am. I cannot change. I am hopeless.</p>	<p>God's Truth: Regeneration</p> <p>I am absolutely complete in Christ.</p> <p>2 Corinthians 5:17, NIV – <i>“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!”</i></p>	<p>God's Truth: Propitiation</p> <p>I am deeply loved by God.</p> <p>1 John 4:9-10, NIV – <i>“This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice [propitiation] for our sins.”</i></p>
