

Four Biblical Images Concerning My Identity

Loveseat – Intimate (Acceptance) – I am not rejected or distant from God. I am seated on the throne at the right hand of God, with my head on the Father’s breast.

Ephesians 2:6, NIV – “*And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus.*”



Lamb – Forgiven (Purity) – Every time the Father looks at the throne, He does not see my sins and failures, but instead He sees the lamb of God, standing slain for me, that I might be cleansed.
