

- Mark 2:10-11, NIV – (10) *He said to the paralytic, (11) “I tell you, get up, take your mat and go home.”*
- e) Peter Never Required More Of People
 - Acts 3:6-7, NIV – (6) *Then Peter said, “Silver or gold I do not have, but what I have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk.” (7) Taking him by the right hand, he helped him up, and instantly the man's feet and ankles became strong.*

5. Act On It

- Luke 17:12-14, NIV – (12) *As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him. They stood at a distance (13) and called out in a loud voice, “Jesus, Master, have pity on us!” (14) When he saw them, he said, “Go, show yourselves to the priests.” And as they went, they were cleansed.*
- John 5:7-9, NIV – (7) *“Sir”, the invalid replied, “I have no one to help me into the pool when the water is stirred. While I am trying to get in, someone else goes down ahead of me.” (8) Then Jesus said to him, “Get up! Pick up your mat and walk.” (9) At once the man was cured; he picked up his mat and walked.*
- Acts 14:8-10, NIV – (8) *In Lystra there sat a man crippled in his feet, who was lame from birth and had never walked. (9) He listened to Paul as he was speaking. Paul looked directly at him, saw that he had faith to be healed (10) and called out, “Stand up on your feet!” At that, the man jumped up and began to walk.*

6. Confess It

- a) Confession Results In Salvation
 - Romans 10:10, NASB – (10) *For with the heart man believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.*
 - “Confesses” = “homologeo” (Greek) = “to come into unity or agreement with the spoken word
 - “Salvation” = “soteria” (Greek) = “deliverance (spiritual, emotional or physical), salvation”
- b) How To Confess
 - i. Confess “Thank you Jesus”
 - ii. Confess “I receive”
 - iii. Confess Scripture

BASIC QUESTIONS ABOUT HEALING

1. Who Can Receive Healing?

a) Jesus Paid The Price For A Complete Salvation

- John 19:30, NIV – (30) *When he had received the drink, Jesus said, “It is finished.” With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.*
- Romans 10:13, NIV – (13) *for, “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”*

b) Complete Salvation Includes Healing

- Isaiah 53:4-5, NIV – (4) *Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows [pain], yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. (5) But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.*
- 1 Peter 2:24, NIV – (24) *and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.*

c) Healing Is Offered To ALL

- Romans 10:13, NIV – (13) *For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.*

2. Who Can Minister Healing?

a) God Uses Human Vessels

b) Every Believer Can Minister Healing

- Mark 16:17-18, NIV – (17) *And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name ... (18) ... they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well.”*
- Believe that God’s word is true, and if you put it into practice, you’ll get results

- c) You Have The Same Spirit And Power That Jesus Did
- Romans 8:11, NIV – (11) *And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you.*
- d) Know You Have His Power!
- Ephesians 1:18-20, NIV – (18) *I pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, (19) and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is like the working of his mighty strength, (20) which he exerted in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms.*
 - Ephesians 3:20, NIV – (20) *Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us.*

HOW TO BE HEALED

1. Come To The Healer

- John 7:37, NIV – (37) ... *Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, “If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink.”*
- Matthew 11:28, NIV – (28) *“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.”*
- Matthew 22:3, NIV – (3) *He sent his servants to those who had been invited to the banquet to tell them to come, but they refused to come.*
- James 5:14, NIV – (14) *Is any one of you sick? He should call the elders of the church to pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord.*
- John 5:6, NIV – (6) *When Jesus saw him lying there and learned that he had been in this condition for a long time, he asked him, “Do you want to get well?”*

2. Receive By Faith

- Faith is believing that a person IS ABLE to do what they have promised, and WILL do what they have promised.
- Matthew 9:28, NIV – (28) ... *the blind men came to him, and he asked them, “Do you believe that I am able to do this?” “Yes, Lord,” they replied.*
- Matthew 9:29, NIV – (29) *Then he touched their eyes and said, “According to your faith will it be done to you”.*

- Matthew 13:58, NIV – (58) *And he did not do many miracles there because of their lack of faith.*
- Mark 6:5-6, NIV – (5) *He could not do any miracles there, except lay his hands on a few sick people and heal them. (6) And he was amazed at their lack of faith. ...*

3. Trust Jesus In The Healer

a) Jesus Is In Us, And Working With Us

- Matthew 28:20, NIV – (20) ... *And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”*
- John 14:17, NIV – (17) *the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.*
- Mark 16:20, NIV – (20) *Then the disciples went out and preached everywhere, and the Lord worked with them and confirmed his word by the signs that accompanied it.*

b) You Must Trust Jesus In The Person

c) You Must Trust That God Will Use The Person

- Matthew 9:28, NIV – (28) ... *“Do you believe that I am able to do this?” “Yes, Lord,” they replied.*

d) God Uses Signs To Get Us To Have Confidence In A Person

e) You Must Have Faith In The Person!

4. Don't Try To Help

a) Get Out Of The Way

b) Relax!

c) You Don't Need To Do Anything, But Receive

- John 14:10, NIV – (10) *Don't you believe that I am in the Father, and that the Father is in me? The words I say to you are not just my own. Rather, it is the Father, living in me, who is doing his work.*

d) Jesus Never Required More Of People

- Matthew 8:2-3, NIV – (2) *A man with leprosy came and knelt before him and said, “Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean.” (3) Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. “I am willing,” he said. “Be clean!” Immediately he was cured of his leprosy.*
